CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jim Goldsworthy called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

INVOCATION & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Jerry Jones, Whaley United Methodist Church, gave the invocation. Mayor Jim Goldsworthy led the pledge to the flag.

PROCLAMATIONS/RECOGNITIONS Employee of the Month, December 2016

Jerry Rhodes was named December 2016 Employee of the Month in recognition and appreciation for his hard work and dedication to the Public Services Department and the City of Gainesville. Jerry has played an instrumental role with the new Cartograph system. He instructs and helps other employees with the new system while maintaining good working relationships with all of his coworkers and other departments as well. Jerry plans ahead for his work load and assists his supervisor by taking charge of situations when necessary. His knowledge is valuable and helpful to all employees in his crew. Jerry is a dependable, hardworking crew leader that the City can count on and trust. He always gets the job done with quality and in a timely manner. CONSENT AGENDA

Council reviewed the Minutes of the workshop session of December 6, 2016 and the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting of December 6, 2016 and approved them as written.

Councilmember Keeler **moved to approve the consent agenda**, seconded by Councilmember Gordon, the motion carried by vote of 7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Absent.

RESOLUTION 12-20-2016 – CANCELLING THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 3, 2017.

CONSIDERATION OF AND ACTION ON A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, TEXAS TO RESCHEDULE OR CANCEL THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 3, 2017.

Council voted to cancel the January 3, 2017 regularly scheduled council meeting due to lack of agenda items. Mayor Jim Goldsworthy also cited the upcoming New Year's Day holiday and short week as reason to cancel. The next meeting will take place Tuesday, January 17, 2017.

Councilmember Clegg **moved to approve the resolution.** The motion was seconded by Councilmember Dollar and carried by vote of 7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Absent.

ORDINANCE 1401-12-2016 – REPEALING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE I SECTIONS 5-1 THROUGH 5-8 AND 5-10; RENUMBERING SECTION 5-9 TO 5-12, SECTION 5-11 TO 5-13, AND SECTIONS 5-12 - 5-25 TO 5-14 - 5-25; ADDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE I. BUILDING STANDARDS, SECTIONS 5-1 THROUGH 5-11.

CONSIDERATION OF AND SECOND READING OF AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE I SECTIONS 5-1 THROUGH 5-8 AND 5-10; RENUMBERING SECTION 5-9 TO 5-12, SECTION 5-11 TO 5-13, AND SECTIONS 5-12 - 5-25 TO 5-14 - 5-25; ADDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE I. BUILDING STANDARDS, SECTIONS 5-1 THROUGH 5-11; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Council considered second reading of an ordinance adopting 2015 International Building Codes and assorted other codes, including Residential Code, Fire Code with Appendices, Plumbing Code, Fuel Gas Code, Mechanical Code, Energy Conservation Code, Property Maintenance Code, and the 2014 National Electric Code NFPA 70. The International Code Council updates these codes every three years. Recommendation amendments were made by City Staff, including Julie Smith, Community Services Director, Jason Botcher, Fire Marshal, Barry Sullivan, City Manager, and Mike Doughty, Countywide Inspections Services, and the North Central Texas Council for Governments. Mayor Goldsworthy thanked city staff for their hard work.

First reading consideration was held at the December 6, 2016 regular meeting. City Council held a workshop session prior to the regular meeting on December 6, 2016 to discuss adoption of said codes, as well. Staff was directed to make several changes following the workshop session.

Councilmember Clegg moved to Suspend the Charter requirement of three readings, seconded by Councilmember Moore, the motion carried by vote of 7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Absent.

Councilmember Clegg moved to Adopt the Ordinance on the Second Reading, seconded by Councilmember Keeler, the motion carried by vote of 7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Absent.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:44 p.m. Mayor Jim Goldsworthy announced that Council would convene into Executive Session in compliance with Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated, Government Code, Chapter 551 (Open Meetings Act), to discuss the following:
