

ORDINANCE NO. 1483-11-2020

AN ORDINANCE REMOVING THE NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE 100 BLOCK OF EAST PECAN STREET; AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF SIGNS; REPEALING OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND MAKING AN OPEN MEETINGS FINDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville currently does not allow parking on the south side of the 100 Block of East Pecan Street; and

WHEREAS, parking was restricted in this area to allow fire apparatus to exit and enter Fire Station Number 3 that was located at the corner of Rusk and Pecan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville has stopped utilizing the fire station at this location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. Determination of Parking Zone.

The City Council hereby finds and determines that the no-parking zone on the south side of the 100 Block of East Pecan shall be removed.

Section 2. Authorization to Remove Signs.

The City Manager of the City of Gainesville, Texas, or his designee shall remove the no-parking signs designating the described location.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances of the City of Gainesville in conflict with this Ordinance and not specifically repealed herein are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.

Section 4. Severability.

It is hereby declared to be intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 5. Open Meeting Finding.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.
